Donor Wall & Brick Pavers

In addition to the naming opportunities detailed above, a donor wall and brick pavers will be prominently located on the campus as a permanent reminder—for generations to come—of those whose interest and generous support have made Save the Family’s success a reality. For a fee, the donor wall & brick pavers will be inscribed with either the donor’s name, in memory of, or in honor of, as specified by the donor.

Note: Amounts indicated do not necessarily reflect the actual construction costs, but are an indication of the memorial or tribute value. Donors will be offered a selection of commemorative naming opportunities based on the amount and date of their gift commitment. Gifts may be paid over a five-year period. Naming opportunity will be in effect for a five-year period or as agreed upon.
