

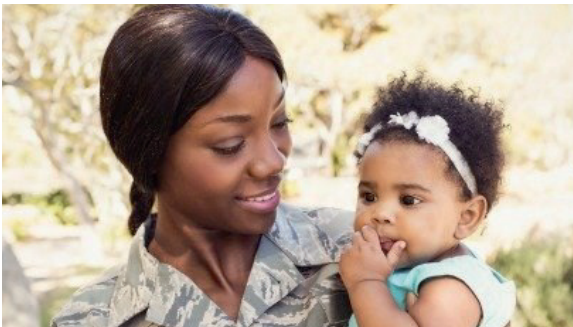

## Valor on Eighth

### AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR VETERAN WOMEN WITH CHILDREN

**Female Veterans comprise just 17% of the veteran population, but they are four times more likely to end up homeless than veteran men.**



Service related disabilities, like PTSD, is a major cause of homelessness, coupled with rising costs of childcare and lack of affordable housing.

With the help of the City of Tempe and affordable housing developer, Gorman & Co., Save the Family has built the first-of-its-kind affordable housing community in Arizona that is specifically designed for veteran women and their families.

Opened in early 2018 in the heart of Tempe near Rural Road and 8th Street, Valor on Eighth provides 45 units of affordable housing and 5 market rate live/work units. Save the Family provides all of the supportive services.

#### Community Amenities Will Include:

- Specialized veteran family case coordination services
- Career services, parenting and life-skill classes and financial literacy and budgeting programs
- Children's programs, including HEAD START and a Teen Room/activity center
- Computer Lab for employment/education
- A Family fitness center, community rooms and gathering spaces
- State of the Art Playground sponsored by the Arizona Diamondbacks
- Access to light rail, ASU and jobs/education
