Values Instilled As a Child

Hanan came to Save the Family when she was just four years old. She arrived with her mom and her brother after her mother escaped a relationship fraught with domestic violence. When they arrived, all they had were the clothes on their backs and a backpack each, filled with their most precious belongings.

Upon her arrival, and now with her children safe, Hanan’s mom quickly got the kids enrolled in youth programs while she regrouped and reentered the workforce. Hanan was provided a blanket crocheted by a women’s group that hand makes them for Save the Family clients. The family also got a box filled with food, bedding, and a few changes of clothes for the family.

Hanan’s mom instilled the strong values she was learning through and reinforced in Save the Family programs. She ensured her children knew how important it was to get an education, finish high school, and seek a college degree. **Hanan’s mom finished her college degree while at Save the Family and later went on to earn a master’s degree.**

Fast forward to today; Hanan is currently enrolled at Gateway Community College, attending on a Nina Mason Pulliam scholarship. She plans to one day become a social worker to help families like hers. She is raising her two-year-old daughter, Amina, while juggling work and school.

Hanan credits her family’s time at Save the Family with providing her a semblance of home and stability during the most trying of times. She is working hard so that her daughter will never experience the struggles she experienced as a child. Hanan says, *“You can lose everything – your home, your car, your freedom, but nobody can take your education or your knowledge.”*
