Veteran women are more than twice as likely as non-Veteran women to experience homelessness.

Since opening in early 2018, Valor on 8th has focused on serving female veterans and their families, providing stable homes, promoting safe children, and fostering strong families.



Housing

Valor on 8th is an affordable housing community designed with women veteran and their families in mind. Offering 45 affordable units and 5 live/work units right along public transportation routes near the Arizona State University campus, Valor provides stable housing while positioning families to take the next steps toward self-sufficiency.



Support Services

Save the Family staff provide Career Development Services, access to a food pantry and clothing closet, and a host of other programs to meet the needs of families in our programs. Veteran-specific services are provided so that families can access benefits programs to which they are entitled through their service and so that resources are maximized for the benefit of the community.



Youth Programs

Valor on 8th offers a range of features and programs designed to provide safe and constructive places for youth to learn and grow. An on-site playground, teen room, after-school programming, and a Head Start facility create spaces where children feel welcome and thrive.
