Our Services

HOUSING

We offer stability and housing programs to meet the unique needs of each family we serve. Rapid Rehousing, Transitional, Eviction Prevention, Tenant Based Rental Assistance, and Step Up to Independence™ make up our impactful housing programs.

CASE MANAGEMENT

We utilize best practices including Housing First, Critical Time Intervention, Progressive Engagement, Trauma Informed Care, Motivational Interviewing, and comprehensive reporting to measure and track our family's progress, maximizing the chances of long-term success for each family.

SUPPORTIVE SERVICES

Including career development, parent support, mental health and substance abuse support, and financial literacy classes.

CHILDREN'S SERVICES

Focuses on the needs of each child, providing necessary intervention to continue their development, and break the cycle of systemic poverty that has afflicted their lives. This can include trauma therapy, educational support, summertime and after-school programs, extracurricular support, life-skills classes, and much more.

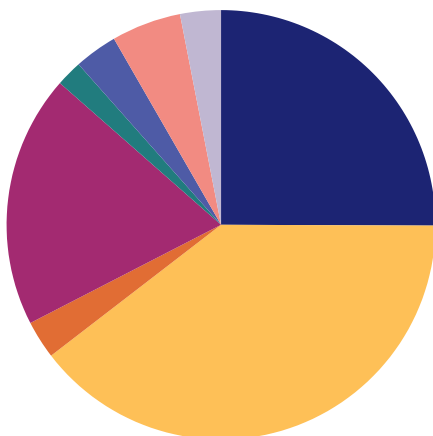

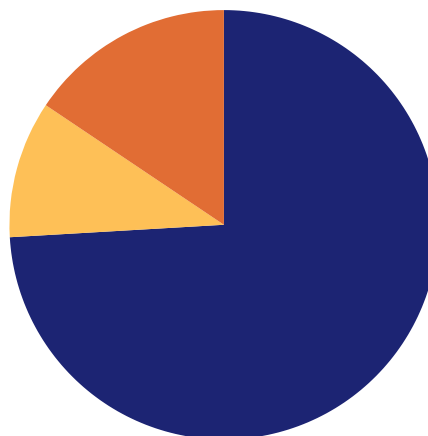
